Did You Know? MONEY- A.D. (ANNO DOMINI) (IN THE YEARS OF OUR LORD)

According to the Gospel of Matthew (Matthew 26:14-16), Judas Iscariot, one of Jesus' twelve disciples, approached the chief priests and agreed to betray Jesus in exchange for **thirty pieces of silver**. This act of betrayal led to Jesus' arrest and crucifixion. The amount of money offered to Judas is significant for several reasons, both historically and theologically.

* The coinage act of 1792 – Passed by congress to establish the first U.S. mint and standardized coinage. Copper, Silver, and Gold. Philadelphia (Nation's capital at the time.). David Rittenhouse was the first mint director. Alexander Hamilton- first secretary of the Treasury.

* First coins- 1793 Half Cent-----Large Cent---- 1794 Dollar
