Did You Know? Capped Bust also called turban head (1807-1839).

Lady liberty wearing a cap- Classic Head Cents, the Half Dime, Dime, Quarter, Half Dollar and Gold coins. Designer- John Reich. This era features larger sized dimes and quarters, a unique eagle on the reverse, the motto E. Pluribus Unum is again featured in the form of the "motto", and a return to facing left from the early Left-facing Half-Dime of 1792 & half cent of 1793. The silver coins were 89.2% silver to 10.8% copper.
