Did You Know? LIBERTY (BARBER) COINAGE (1892-1916)

This design is considered by many, as being boring and "least liked" of all U.S. mint designs. I must admit, the design is growing on me as I get older/wiser. These coins typically see tons of wear as they made many millions, collectors didn't seem to like them, as well as being found in circulation well into the 1950s... Barber coins in mint state are rare. Charles E Barber – Mint director and designer of this period.

(NOTE- FIRST TIME THERE WAS NO DOLLAR DESIGN OFFERED)(TRADE AND MORGAN DOLLAR WERE MADE SEPERATLY FOR BOTH THE ORIENTAL TRADE AND TO SATISFY THE SILVER STRIKE IN NEVADA.
